Mr. Brown is currently the Chief of Operations for Spherix. With nearly 20 years in the pharmaceutical industry, his primary area of expertise is in large global clinical trials. Mr. Brown has worked with companies such as Pfizer, Eli Lilly, and Genetech. His positions have mainly been in management within the operations area. He has experience managing global trials in roughly 30 different countries including new emerging areas such as India and Eastern Europe. Mr. Brown led the efforts for the Spherix Phase 3 study in India where more than 500 patients were screened across 24 sites, in less than 30 days.

Mr. Brown develops effective drug development strategies, and manages changes to established strategies upon receipt of new information. He manages all key aspects of Clinical Study Execution (design, initiation, conduct, query, analysis, and summarization) to ensure on-time achievement of corporate goals. Mr. Brown identifies and oversees effective and efficient approaches for communications and submissions to regulatory agencies.

Mr. Brown also led the Phase 2 and Phase 3 programs for activated Protein C (now Xigris) which is the only approved compound for Sepsis. This trial randomized thousands of patients worldwide and is considered the benchmark for global trials within critical care.

Mr. Brown has significant experience in program management from Phase 1 to Phase 4 work. He has also worked very closely with DMSBs monitoring critical endpoints, and with the FDA negotiating label claims and securing NDA approvals.
